Some Practical Suggestions

- 1. Have a daily **Quiet Time** alone with God.
- 2. Have **specific times** *every day* (morning and evening)
- 3. Have a **specific place** of meeting with Him
- 4. **Keep** this appointment with God
- 5. *Remember the goal* is to know Jesus Christ, to have fellowship with Him, to continue to be with Him, to love Him, to worship Him, to become like Him, to secure His presence for the day, and to glorify Him.
- 6. *Remember, the Holy Spirit* will teach you all things and guide you as you look to God, trust Him and listen to His voice.

7. Practically:

GO into your quiet meeting place

CLOSE the door to all distractions

Become quiet before Him, aware of His presence

PRAY

READ the portion for the day...

slowly, carefully, prayerfully, sometimes loudly, listening to God speaking to you

THINK with your head and heart;

ask yourself specific *questions* about the portion; *apply* it to your life

WRITE NOTES/ underline/ mark

PRAY: Adoration Confession Thanksgiving Supplication

MEMORIZE a portion or verse

GO and DO what the Lord wants/ shows me to DO

To His glory!

Am/a PARTNER in sins?!

Many times some of us have **Questions** like:

- 1. If God convicted <u>me</u> of sin and I go to confess it and bring it into the light (seeking His forgiveness and victory), if that sin involved another person, **should I tell** about him/her?
- 2. Will I be a "pimp" or not?
- 3. If <u>I</u> tell everything I may cause <u>them</u> to "get into trouble" and I don't want to do that. Is that right or not?
- 4. Is it right before God to keep quiet?
- 5. But, on the other hand, is it right to "confess someone else's sins"?
- 6. Some say that if I tell other's sins I do not act in a Christian way, but is that true?
- 7. What should I do? What is God's way of doing it? What is God's will?

I become a PARTNER in other's sins if...

- 1. I am not grieving for their sins.
- 2. I conceal (hide) what I ought to reveal.
- 3. I approve of their sins (and not reprove it), or defend it.
- 4. I do not separate myself from them when God tells me to.
- 5. I desire to do it myself.
- 6. I do it myself.

I am not grieving for their sins

2 Peter 2:7 - "...a righteous man, who was **DISTRESSED** by the filthy lives of lawless men" (and women).

Psalm 119:136 - "I CRY rivers of tears, for your law is not obeyed." Ezekiel 9:4-6 - Do not kill "those who GRIEVE and lament over all the detestable things that are done in it" (the city)

I conceal (hide) what I ought to reveal

Leviticus 5:1 - "If a person SINS because he **DOES NOT SPEAK UP** when he hears a public charge to testify regarding something he has seen or learned about, he will be held responsible."(NIV). "If anyone SINS in that he is sworn to testify and has knowledge of the matter, either by seeing or by hearing of it, but **FAILS TO REPORT IT**, then he shall bear his iniquity and willfulness." (Ampl)

Proverbs 29:24 - "The ACCOMPLICE of a thief is his own enemy; he is put under oath and DARE NOT TESTIFY." (NIV). "Whoever is PARTNER with a thief hates his own life; he falls under the curse [pronounced upon him who KNOWS who the thief is] BUT DISCLOSES NOTHING." (Ampl)

Deutoronomy 13: 6-10 and 2 John 10,11 and Prov 8:13 ...READ! If another's sins are never exposed and confessed, it will NOT go well with him/her. It's wrong to say "I'll bring so-and-so in trouble if I tell", because they are already in trouble with God (if they sinned)!! NOT to tell and not to repent will cause bigger trouble (in hell) than any other "trouble"!!!



Pray "Lord, I want to be clean and follow You only. Amen."







13 January: Changed!

Pray "Lord, please show me yourself." **Read** Genesis 31-32 and Matthew 10:24-42. Think + write Isaac called God the "..."(Gen 31:53). This means that Pro 9:10, "The is the beginning of wisdom." Pro 8:13, "The fear of the Lord is to I read in Gal 6:7, "Do not be deceived... A man reaps what he sows." This is clearly shown in the life of Jacob. He was a deceiver (Gen 25:26). He deceived his father (27:35) and his father-in-law (31:20), but Laban and his wife Rachel deceived him (29:25 and 31:34). His own heart also deceived him (Jer 17:9). The Deceived **Deceiver** came to a Dead-end Desperation (in ch 32), which ended in a Divine encounter and a glorious *change* and **Deliverance** (ch33). The **STEPS** included (in ch 32): (1) He realized the danger he was in (v7), (2) He remembered the Word of the Lord and reminded Him of it (v9). (3) He realized and acknowledged "I amof all" (v10), (4) He prayed to God for salvation (v11), (5) He separated from all he had and sent all across the Jabbok river (v22,23), (6) He was left (v24), with God, (7) He wrestled alone with God (v24), (8) God wounded and "broke" him (v25), (8) He consequently refused to let go of God until God blessed him (v26), (9) He was honest with God (v27), (10) He saw God face to face (v30), (11) Then God "..... him there" (v29), changed his name (and character), and the dark night of his soul changed into day - the sun rose above him and in his life!(v31). Jesus said in Matt 10:28, "Rather, of the One who can destroy both soul and body in hell." To fear God (in the true sense of the word) and to love Him is life. He said "anyone who loves his father or mother more than me is not worthy of me"(v37)...me is not worthy of me" (v38). **Pray** "Lord, please change me too!" Go + Do what Jacob did at "Jabbok" (which means "pouring out")

14 January: Be violent!

Pray "Lord, make me like You." **Read** Genesis 33-35 and Matthew 11 Think + write **Jacob** was reconciled with his brother, because he (1).....(ch 32) and (2)(Gen 33:3). **Dinah** was "violated" by a man (34:2). Take note, just after her father built an altar to worship the Lord (33:20), the Bible says, "Now, Dinahwent out to visit the women of the land"!!(34:1). From this I learn:. Jacob (35:2-3) said to his family: "Get rid of the foreign gods you have with you, and purify yourselves and Then **come**, let us **go up**..." Jesus says: "....the kingdom of heaven has been forcefully advancing, and forceful men lay hold of it." (Matt 11:12). In the KJV I read "the violent take it by force." Also see Luke 16:16 and Acts 14:22b. I need to be VIOLENT AGAINST SIN in all forms. I need to KILL "whatever belongs to my earthly nature: "sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry" (Col 3:5). According to Matt 5:29-30, if my right hands causes me to stumble, I need to Cut it off. Cast it away, and not Care for it any more!! I need to be **VIOLENT AGAINST SELF** in me. This means(See Gal 2:20, Luke 9:23). It also means that I keep under my body (1 Co 9:27). To ME this means:..... I need to be **VIOLENT AGAINST WORLDLY INFLUENCES.** See Gal 6:14 and 1 John 2:15-17. I also need to be VIOLENT AGAINST SATAN & SPIRITS of evil. God says I need to "resist", "wrestle against" and "fight" against them. I do this through Christ's Victory on the Cross over them all! (Col 2:15 and 1 John 3:8). John Owen said: "Without violent affections (for God and heaven) we shall never resist violent temptations." **Pray** "Lord Jesus, I won't let anything hinder my love for You." Go + Do what I must do - with holy violence against all that is not of God in me.






WHAT to cut off?

- 1. Cut off <u>SIN</u>. "The evil deeds of a wicked man ensnare him; the cords of his SIN hold him fast. He will die..." (Prov 5:22), unless he cuts it off!
- 2. Cut off <u>CORDS</u> of sin. Cut off the "soul ties", the emotional ties, the spirit-ties with those with whom you have sinned.
- 3. Cut off the <u>CAUSES</u> of sin. Your right hand (Matt 5), if necessary your cell phone, your TV, your computer games, your music DVDs, your Tablet, your internet connection, etc...
- 4. Cut off the <u>COMMUNITY</u> of sinners. Num 15:28-30 "Anyone who sins defiantly... must be cut off from the people..."
- 5. Cut off the <u>CONSEQUENCES</u> of sin. See Ezra 9:1-4; 10:1-3,9-12. NOT "confess and carry on", but "confess and cut off...!"
- 6. Cut off the <u>CORDS</u> that wrongly bind you to your parents/ relatives' sins. See Luke 14:26-27 and Eze 16:4 "your umbilical cord was not cut...". Also read Deut 13:6-11... "even your ...lifelong friend don't go along with him; shut your ears. Don't feel sorry for him and don't make excuses for him. Kill him..." spiritually speaking...

Oswald Chambers wrote:

"CUT IT OFF."

My heart is bleeding, and my spirit's wrung with pain, Yet I hear my Jesus pleading, "CUT IT OFF or all is vain."

Will you DO IT ?!

15 January: **Bruised?**

Pray "Lord, please speak to me through Your Word. Amen." Read Genesis 36-37 and Matthew 12:1-21 Think + write In Gen 39:2 we read that "the Lord was with Joseph". At the age of 17 he worked for his father, with his brothers (Gen 37:2). He "brought their father a bad report about them"(v2). Why did he do this? Was he right or wrong in doing this? Motivate your answer:(Lev 5:1). What would you have done?.... What was the reaction of his brothers? Did this change Joseph's behaviour towards them? Put in your own words how **Jesus is described** in Matt 12:18-21: I understand "a bruised reed" to mean: A person can be bruised by SIN (Read Pro 6:32-3 and 2 Sam 13). by SOCIETY (Luk 10; and as Joseph's brothers hurt him) by SATAN (Luke 9:39)

by GOD (Read Hosea 5:14-6:2)

Have you been bruised?

Have you been broken?

Jesus came to break the strong and to HEAL the bruised and broken. In the Living Bible we read, "He does not crush the weak or quench the smallest hope" (Matt 12:20). In Isaiah 61:1 I read: "He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted."

Pray "Thank you, Lord!"

 $G_0 + D_0$ what is needed to be healed (Matt 12:13 and 15!).

16 January: Overcome temptation!

Pray "Lord, please teach me Your Way..." **Read** Genesis 38-40 and Matthew 12:22-50

Think + write

Er, Judah's firstborn, was wicked in the Lord's sight; so the Lord(Gen 38:7). I read in Romans 6:23 that "the wages of SIN is but the gift of God isin Christ Jesus our Lord." **Joseph** was different, he feared God and "the Lord was with him" (Gen 39:21). He was severely **TEMPTED**, but he overcame beautifully! To overcome temptation I need to do what Joseph did. He (1) to sin (v8), he (2)away (v12), and he (3) relied on the Lord and (4) remained aware of the Lord's Presence and that he should not sin against God. It's very important to notice that he did not only refuse to sin with this woman (we can call her "Mrs Pot-of-fire"!), but he also refused to "even be with her" (v10). As a young person, it's good to NEVER be alone with a person of the opposite gender. Take note, she made her final onslaught to seduce him when there was no one else in the house...(v11). Because Joseph's **Heart** was right (v10), and his **Head** thought right (v9), and his **Hands** and **Heels** did right (v12), he escaped successfully, by God's grace...

To Overcome Temptation

- 1. **Refuse** to sin or be even near the possibility.
- 2. **Resist** the devil.
- 3. **Run** away when needed.
- 4. **Rely** on the Lord's help (1 Co 10:13).
- 5. **Remember** His Presence.

Pray "Father, thank you that through Your Son I can overcome!" Go + Do as Joseph and Jesus did.

17 January: Fully Fruitful

Pray "Father, please make me like Joseph and Jesus." Read Genesis 41 and Matthew 13:1-32 Think + write Though **Joseph** was far from his family and in Egypt (!), he was victorious and fruitful. Some more of the **treasures** I find in his life are: • When he was asked a difficult thing to do (Gen 41:15), he replied: "I cannot...", "but God will..." (v16). May I also respond like this. • There was a different spirit in him. Pharaoh could not find any man like Joseph, "one in whom is"(v38). • Despite the trauma and sufferings he went through, he said, "God has made me to"(v51). There are some things that only God can make us to forget. We need Him to do that for us. • Joseph also said, "God has made me"(v52). I want to be like that too With a longing that we'll be fruitful, in Matt 13 Jesus tells us about the Sower, the Seed, the Soil, and the Spirits that come to steal the seed. The *Sower* is(see Matt 13:37) The Seed is(see Luke 8:11) The *Soils* are the different hearts of different people. The *Spirits* are represented by the birds (v4,19). Six types of soil are mentioned: 3 not good and 3 good. Some persons have hearts like a path (v4,19), others like rocky places (v5,6,20,21),

others like thorny places ((v7,22), others like good soil (v8,23). It means that:

- 6. Good (100x): It's very important to remember that there is another sower (Satan),

with other seed (weed seed), that'll come and sow his sin-seeds when we are passive and spiritually asleep.... See Matt 13:24-30.

18 January: Good or Bad Seeds?

Prav "Lord, please help me to see myself in Your light." **Read** Genesis 42,43 and Matthew 13:33-58 Think + write It's interesting to notice that when **Benjamin** met up with difficulties, he said, "...." (Gen 42:36), but when Job faced worse difficulties and tragedies, I read in Job 1:20 that "he fell to the ground in"!! This is quite amazing. "Lord, when I encounter challenges, please help me to worship You." In Matt 13:36-43 I learn that we are all SEEDS. We are either "good seed" (v38) or bad seed, "weeds" (v38). The "good seed" stands for the "...." (and daughters) of the kingdom (v38). The bad seeds are the "...." (and daughters) of the evil one, Satan (v38). They are further described as "all who" (v41). Just as a seed germinates and grows down (with roots) and up (with shoots), and bears fruit, in the same way - what we are will be shown by what we grow into and by the fruit in our lives.... In the beginning it may not be visible whether we are good or bad seeds, but after some time, it will be clearly seen by our deeds, our actions. Those who *do* evil, the angels will throw into the ".....", where there will be "....."(v42). This is a reality. Jesus often spoke about a place called "hell". See Luke 12:5, Mark 9:47 and Matt 10:28.

While the weeds (the bad seeds, the "bad boyz" and the "bad girls") will burn in hell-fire, the true sons and daughters of God, the good seeds (by God's work of salvation), will shine like the sun(v43).

In Matt 13:45-46 I read in the Amplified version that "the kingdom of heaven is like a man who is a dealer in search of fine and *precious pearls*, Who, on finding *a single pearl of great price*, went and sold <u>all</u> he had and bought it." He gave <u>ALL FOR JESUS!!</u>

Pray "Lord Jesus, You are to me the most Precious Pearl..." **Go + Do** what good seeds do: grow and bear good fruit.

19 January: Wicked Woman or Broken Bread?

Pray "Father, show me how You want me to be. Amen." **Read** Genesis 44,45 and Matthew 14:1-21 Think + write Women and men who are evil will always be irritated by the truth. This is why *Herodias* (who lived in adultery with Herod) wanted to silence the voice of John the Baptist. She had him beheaded (Matt 14:10), just like Kali did and still do with many of her victims. This same spirit was also in the woman called Jezebel. She manipulated her husband and ruled over him; she tried to kill Elijah; she "painted her eyes and beautified her head..."(2 Kings 9:30); she was involved in demonic activity; and she arranged the murder of an innocent person. Jezebel, referred to by Jesus in Rev 2:20-23, misled some of God's"(v20). What made it worse in this church of Thyatira was that this woman seemed very "spiritual" and even "prophesied" in the church (Rev 2:20). Some people may appear very "spiritual", while they are in fact very sinful and lustful, and under the influence of evil spirits... This is (unfortunately) true of both women and men, as well as young men and young women. Their only hope is to repent deeply and to come to Jesus with all their heart, and be changed by Him... Instead of feeding selfish, fleshly appetites and lusts, it is better to let God do with me as He did with the five loaves of bread (Matt 14:17-21). The BREAD was • **Brought** to Jesus (v18); put in His hands... • **Blessed** by Him (v19 in KJV) • **Broken** by Him (v19) • **Brought** and given to the people in need (v19) Have I become "broken bread" (as Oswald Chambers said) for others and not for self?! To me, this means that:

Pray "Lord, make me broken bread for others, for You. Amen."

 $G_0 + D_0$ whatever His hands lead me to do.

20 January: How to Walk on Water!

Pray "Lord, please teach me how to deal with the storms of life."

Read Genesis 46-48 and Matthew 14:22-36

Think + write

Life is not easy. We all meet with different storms and difficulties, also at home and at school or at work. The question is, "How to walk on the water - in the midst of the storm?" The disciples were in a heavy storm in the night, out on the open sea.... Like Jesus, Peter was enabled to walk on the water and do what was (and is) humanly impossible. What made it possible?

As he spoke to Pharaoh, Israel showed himself:

- <u>HOLY</u> (fully devoted and focused on God and not man, not even Pharaoh),
- **HONEST** (v9b: "My years have been few and difficult"),
- <u>HUMBLE</u> (v9c: "they do not equal the years of the pilgrimage of my fathers"), and
- <u>HEAVENLY</u> minded (v9a: "The years of my pilgrimage" on earth)

Pray "Lord, please make me so too - for Your Name's sake. Amen." Go + Do what Jesus calls me to, even if it looks impossible.

21 January: "...but God"

Prav "Father, please help me to see what You can do." **Read** Genesis 49-50 and Matthew 15:1-20 Think + write Before he died, Jacob said that *Joseph* would (1) be fruitful (Gen 49:22 -24), (2) be near a spring (Jesus), (3) grow and extent, (4) overcome obstacles, (5) remain steady despite vicious attacks, and (6) rest "in the Strength that does not fail him" (Ampl). All of this BECAUSE of(v24). May it also become true in MY life. After Jacob's death, Joseph's brothers were afraid that he would hold a (50:15) against them and pay them back for the evil they did to him, but he said: "You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives" (Gen 50:20). The Bible is full of "...but God" statements! See Rom 5:8, 1 Co 10:13, Eph 2:4, Phil 2:27, etc. Sin can slay, but God can save...! Self can spoil, **but God** can sanctify (and make holy)...! Society can reject, but God can accept...! Satan can destroy, but God can deliver...! As long as we live, and as long as we are in God's time of grace (which is "Now"), there is always a "....but God" (can)! NO MATTER WHAT YOU HAVE DONE OR WHERE YOU FIND YOURSELF SPIRITUALLY AT THIS MOMENT - WHATEVER HAP-PENED, KNOW "BUT GOD" CAN CHANGE EVERYTHING!! PROVIDED YOU COME TO HIM WITH ALL YOUR HEART - NOW. In Romans 8:28 I read, "And we know that in all things..... for the good of those who Him, who have been called according to his purpose." According to Matt 15:19 a man or a woman is made UNCLEAN be-blame Satan or society... "but God" can CLEANSE us!!

Pray "Lord, I see it is my own heart that is the root of all my problems. Please cleanse my heart and change my heart."

 $\mathbf{Go} + \mathbf{Do}$ what God told me to do, so that He can do what He needs to do.

22 January: I'll go through with God

Pray "Lord Jesus, I praise Your Name. You can do anything!" **Read** Exodus 1-3 and Matthew 15:21-39

Think + write

Satan hates it when we prosper and grow in grace and fruitfulness. I read in Exodus how, gradually, over a period of many years, the people of God were enslaved by the Egyptians. The oppression and the slavery was terrible and very severe. Their ultimate deliverance was preceded by a period of PREPARATION for DELIVERANCE. During this time:

- 1. They **Cried** to God for deliverance (Ex 3:7,9);
- 2. God was **Concerned** about their suffering (v7);
- 3. He Came down to rescue them (v8); and
- 4. He Called and Commissioned Moses (after his 80 years of preparation, 40 in Egypt and 40 in the desert) to lead them out (v4,10)

During this time, God also used certain women. These women of God were true heroines, true soldiers of Christ, ones for whom I have the greatest respect. They:

Think + write God wanted to use Moses, but Moses made some <u>EXCUSES</u> (Ex 3:11 and 4:10,13). Some of the common excuses people use for not evangelizing and leading others out of bondage are:
Whatever my "excuse", God says: "Now go; I will
When we are engaged in spiritual warfare , especially when we pray on behalf of people who are slaves of Satan (through sin), we can tell the forces of darkness: "THIS IS WHAT GOD SAYS: 'LET MY PEOPLE GO!!'" In Jesus' Name, we can command those evil spirits to let God's people go, because God says so, and because Jesus has already conquered or the Cross!! See also Matt 16:19 and 23.
God said, " <u>I will</u> bring you out", " <u>I will</u> free you", " <u>I will</u> redeem you", " <u>I will</u> take you as my own", " <u>I will</u> be your God", " <u>y will</u> bring you" (See Ex 6:6-8). Despite all these promises, they did not listen (!), because of (1)
To FOLLOW Jesus we need to 1.
Pray "Lord Jesus, I choose to follow You and obey You, now."
$\mathbf{Go} + \mathbf{Do}$ as <i>He will help me</i> to do whatever He tells me to do.

24 January: Compromise

Pray "Lord, teach me to pray warfare prayers. Amen." **Read** Exodus 7.8 and Matthew 17 Think + write Moses had to tell Pharaoh (as I have to tell Satan): "The Lord, ...has sent me to say to you: Let my people go, so that they may worship me in the desert" (Ex 7:16). Through the authority given to Jesus (Matt 28:18) I can now engage in aggressive spiritual warfare against the evil spirits that bind people and, in Jesus' Name, command them (based on Jesus' victory over them on the Cross) to let God's people go - that they may worship Him. To pray like this, Jesus taught the disciples that they need (Matt 17:19,20). When Pharaoh reluctantly consented, he suggested four COMPROMISES. Satan also always tempt us to make compromises in our service and worship of the Lord. Pharaoh said they may go, BUT suggested that.... 1. They worship God while they are still in Egypt (Ex 8:25). This means: 2. They don't go very far; they don't go all the way (Ex 8:28). This means: 3. Let *only the men go* and let the children and young people and women stay behind in Egypt (Ex 10:11). This means: 4. Only leave your flocks and herds behind (Ex 10:24). This Remember, "Compromise is the language of the devil!" "It is impossible to compromise with sin and conquer it at the same time." "It is madness for sheep to talk peace with a wolf." According to Ex 9:19-20, there are only **TWO GROUPS of people in** the world: • Those who the word of the Lord, and • Those who the word of the Lord.

Pray "Father, please help us not to ignore Your words. Amen."

Go + Do what I must - without any compromise.

In 1 Co 5:7 I read: "For, our, has been sacrificed." He sacrificed himself for our sins once for all when he offered himself on the Cross (Heb 7:27b). In Rom 6:23 I read that "the wages of sin is" But, because Jesus, "the Lamb of God", was sacrificed, His blood can now be applied in my life and save me from


- the penalty of sin,

27 January : **Getting OUT**

Pray "Lord, lead me in Your way ...OUT of the land of bondage."

Read Exodus 13-15 and Matthew 19:1-15

Think + write

As far as marriage is concerned, Jesus taught that

- **GOD** has to be the one to bring and to join the two people together (Matt 19:6b)
- The man should *LEAVE* his father and mother (completely cutting the apron strings and whatever other strings); Matt 19:5.
- And *CLEAVE* to his wife (and be no longer two, but one); v5.
- They are **NEVER** to be separated (v6,8), and that "anyone who divorces his wife... and marries another woman commits adultery" (v9).

- "With a mighty hand ______" brought the Israelites "OUT of the land of slavery" (Ex 13:14), OUT of bondage.
- They went out, "....."(v18b). Every new Christian should understand and know this. The moment you turn your back on your old life of sin, you must be *ready for battle*!!
- You must also be *ready to be guided by the Lord*. The Lord led them "around by the desert" (v18), though there was a shorter way (v17)... The Lord led them day and night! See v21-22.
- *Be ready to face difficulties* and "impossibilities". The enemy army pursued them from the one side and the Red Sea barred their way on the opposite side, with mountains on both the other sides... (v 9,10). Never think of going back to your old life, as some of them thought of doing (See v12).
- *Follow God's instructions* (v13-15): (1) "<u>Do not be afraid</u>", (2) "<u>Stand firm</u>", (3) "You need only to <u>be still</u>", for "the Lord will fight for you", and (4) "<u>Move on</u>"... Go forward...
- *Listen carefully to God's voice and obey Him* and He will not bring on you any of the diseases He brought on the Egyptians, for He says, "I am the Lord, who heals you" (Ex 15:26). This is wonderful!

Pray and Go + Do what He showed you to do.

28 January: Bread from Heaven!

Pray "Father-God, I trust you completely. Feed me with your Heavenly Bread every day. Amen."

Read Exodus 16-18 and Matthew 19:16-30



Twice we find this said of Abraham, both times in reference to what was painful to him. The first time it was to send away his son Ishmael from his home, and the second time to face the still harder task of offering up Isaac. His early rising was the token of his wholehearted willingness to do the will of God.

How glorious was the reward of his early rising which Abraham received. It brought him on the third day to the mountains where the Lord appeared unto him - and favour followed upon his obedience. He gave him back his son as from the dead. He confirmed to him the promise of blessing: 'In blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying I will multiply thy seed'. Abraham learns to know his God as the worker of wonders of whom he could say, 'The Lord will provide.'

My brother (and sister - my addition)! If ever a day comes when you are called upon to do what seems to you hard and difficult, do as Abraham did. Arise in the morning hour to meet your God in a spirit of willingness to accomplish only His will. If you desire to walk in Abraham's footsteps, and to sacrifice all to God, yea, even what is dearest, then go to meet God in the early morning hour. To you, too, on rising early, He will reveal Himself as the Lord and will provide. To you, too, will He confirm it by an oath, saying, 'In blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying I will multiply thy seed.' Thus was Abraham rewarded for that early rising."


