- Jesus Christ is our Creator-God!
- •Key theme: Beginnings
- •The beginning of everything ...except God!
- Summed up in 8 words: Creation, Fall, Flood, Babel, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob & Joseph
- Key verse: "In the beginning God.." (1:1)

- To demolish building, attack the foundation...
- •If you pull out the first pages, it will not be long before the last pages will be falling out also...
- •In Genesis 1... the Creator > Creation is shown!

Creation

- In the beginning God created...
- Genesis 1 is the most <u>God-centred</u> chapter in Bible... "and God said" x10
- "God" x35 !!!
- "After its kind"... No transmutations

Fall

- Genesis 3
- Serpent tempted Eve;
- Eve tempted Adam (who was passive...)
- Eve was deceived; Adam disobeyed
- lst sin ⇒ separated from God
- 2nd sin ⇒ separated from man

Flood

- Genesis 4-9
- Cain's descendants: worldly-minded
- Seth's descendants: other-worldliness
- The Lord Jesus believed in a literal
 Noah, a literal ark, and a literal Flood...
- God's answer to unrepentant wickedness - judgement by water/fire
