HCFI strives to inspire and equip Christians serving in healthcare to manifest Jesus Christ in their daily life and work.

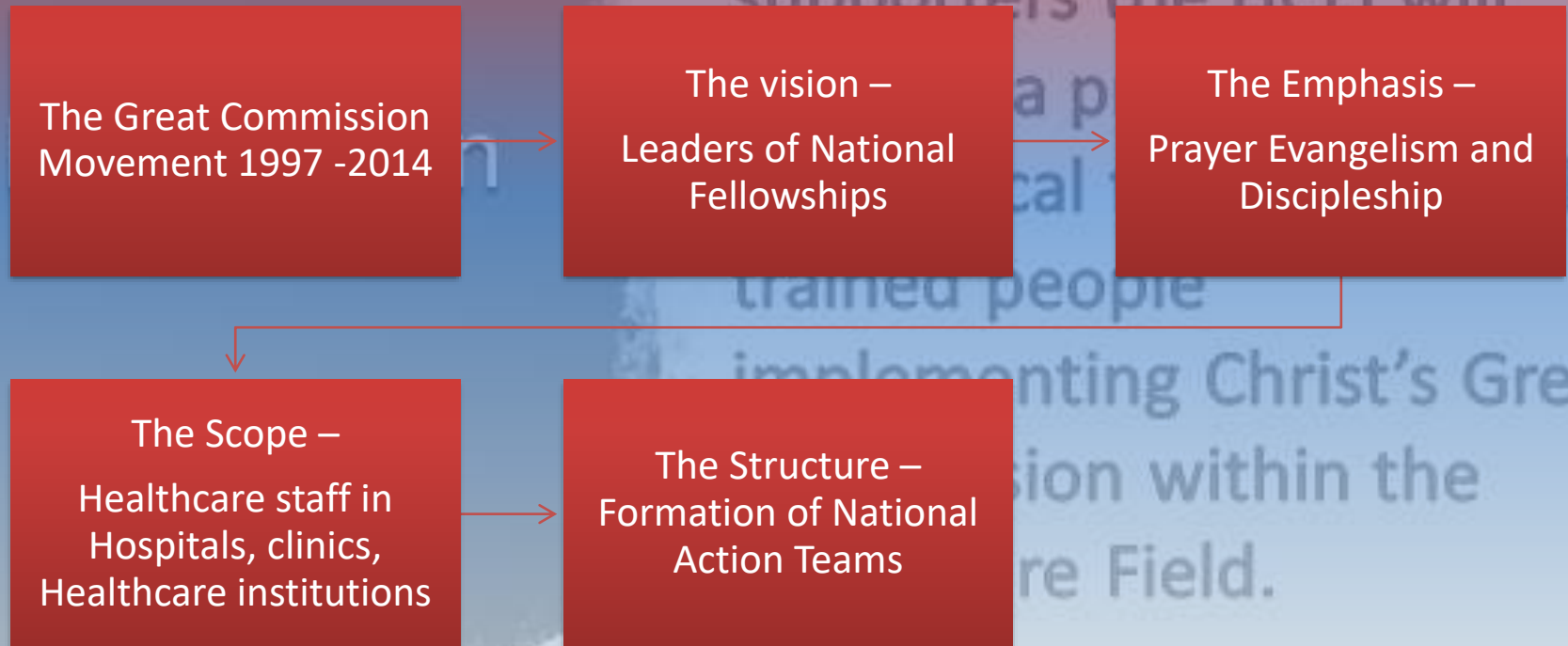

Strong, Struggling, Still and Unreached

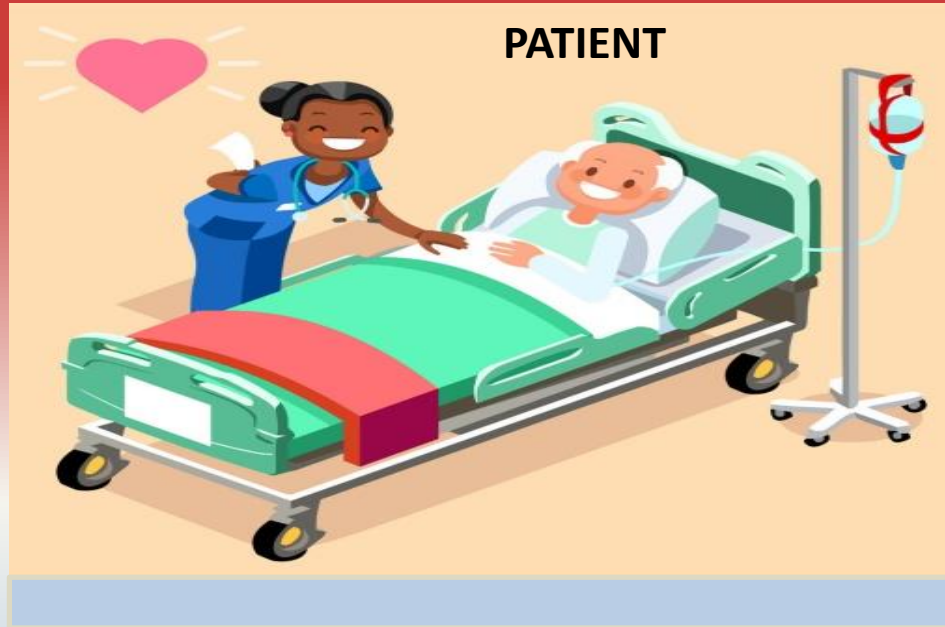

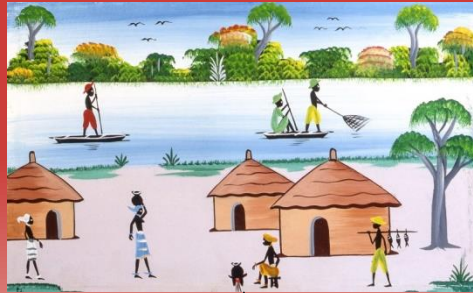

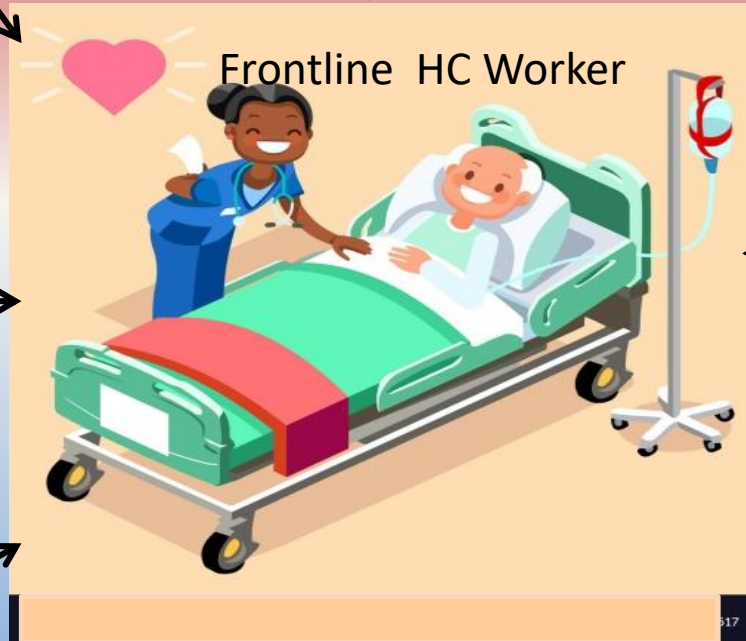
