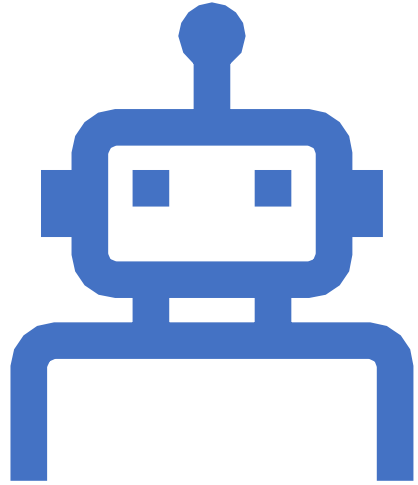

# What is a medical outreach event?

Any event involving provision of free medical services by HCF members to a local community in need, organised by HCF organisation alone or jointly with other christian organisations or churches

These events also provide the opportunity for prayer, evangelism and disciple making



# Why?

---

- Part of the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20)
- Go and heal the sick (Luke 9:1)
  - And He called the twelve together and gave them power and authority over all the demons and to heal diseases.
- Go to those with limited access to medical help, often the poor. (Proverbs 19:17)
  - Whoever is generous to the poor lends to the LORD, and he will repay him for his deed.

# Refugee situation in Kuala Lumpur

- In Malaysia, we have >150,000 refugees (documented)
- As Malaysia did not sign the International Convention for Refugees, these refugees are considered illegal migrants.
- Hence, no access to jobs, education and health.
- HCF Malaysia, together with Health4R, conduct fortnightly Sunday afternoon clinics
- Teams consist of 3-4 doctors, nurses, pharmacists and befrienders
- Communities reached include Rohingyas, Somali, Afghans, Pakistanis



# To date, HCF globally have carried out

- More than 1,000 medical outreaches, big and small ones since 2014
- Impacted more than 50,000 people
- Countries that are active in medical outreaches
  - Myanmar
  - Brazil
  - Cambodia
  - Malaysia
- Not all countries are reporting on their medical outreach activities, due to sensitivities (e.g. Central Asia, China)



How does one  
begin to mobilise  
medical outreaches  
in their own  
country?

Preparation phase. Need an organiser/planner.

- Regular prayer
  - Ask the Lord for nations or unreached people groups or communities
  - Look for the man of peace in that community
  - Which christian organisations or churches would like to join with in this outreach event
- Be Saline trained in witnessing beforehand
- Understand the big story or biblical worldview
- Pray for the right team members to avail themselves, often self-funded
- Fixed the date and venue. Book the transport and accommodation early
- Raise the budget for medicines and equipment



# Implementation

- Meet and assigned specific roles in the team
- Roles and flow
  - Logistics for transport and lay out of the site.
  - Registration triage station
  - Medical and dental stations
  - Pharmacy for medication
  - Prayer/ counselling station
  - Children's ministry, if lots of children present for games, story telling



# Post medical outreach

- Debriefing session
- What went well and what could be improved?
- Have a Follow up plan important with the local churches
- Introduce opportunity for integral community health (ICH) programs in order to transform the local community long term
- Begin Bible discovery group with the community, where possible
