# Psalms

- Jesus Christ as our All in All...!
- Ps 92:2b “...worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness”
- Hebrew title = “Praise”
- David wrote 73 of the 150 psalms.
- “Praise through Prayer”!!!



# Psalms

- The Prayer book of the Bible
- Consist of 5 “books”
- In the Jewish Comment on Ps 1:  
“Moses gave to the Israelites the 5 books of the Law, and as a counterpart to these, David gave the Psalms which consists of 5 Books...”

# Major types of Psalms

- Instruction – 1,5,7,15,50,73,94,101
- History – 78,105,106,136
- Praise – 106,111-113,115-117,135,146-150
- Confession – 6,32,51,102,130,143
- Climbing – 120-134 (or Degrees x15)
- Supplication – 86
- Thanksgiving – 16,18
- Messianic – 2,8,16,20-24,etc....

# Psalm 119

- Nearly all of the 176 verses speak about the Word of God...!
- Longest chapter in the Bible.
- “I seek You with all my heart” (10)
- “I have hidden Your Word in my heart” (11)
- “I meditate on” *Your Word*... (15)
- “I will not neglect *Your Word*...” (16b)



# Psalm 119

- **“Before I was afflicted I went astray, but now I obey Your word...”(v67); “...now I’m in step with Your word” (MSG)**
- **“The law from Your mouth is more precious to me than thousands of pieces of silver and gold...” (v72)**
- **“Your Word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path” (v105)**
- **“My heart is set on keeping Your decrees to the very end” (v112)**

# Psalm 119

- **“The unfolding of Your words gives light” (130)**
- **“Direct my footsteps according to Your word; let no sin rule over me...” (133)**
- **“I rise before dawn and cry for help...” (147)**
- **“My heart trembles at Your word...” (161)**
- **“Great peace have they who love Your law, and nothing can make them stumble...” (165)**



# Psalm 119

- **“How can a young man keep his way pure? By living according to your word.” (9)**
- **“I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you...” (11)**
- **“I will not neglect your word” (16)**
- **“Revive me...according to your word” (25)**

# Psalm 119

- “Nothing is perfect except Your words...  
Oh, how I love them... I think about  
them all day long...” (96-97)



# Psalm 19

- The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul; the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple;
- the precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes;
- the fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever; the rules of the LORD are true, and righteous altogether.
- More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and drippings of the honeycomb.
- Moreover, by them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward.
