

whole life. It includes being saved from all sin. It is “saving health” (Ps 67:2).

Healed healing is therefore *not* a marriage between “East” and “West”, nor “North” and “South”, nor “traditional” and “modern”, nor “spiritual” and “scientific”, nor whatever combination or integration man may think of. No, it is rather a return to what and how God wants us to be and do. Healed healing is to be **from God, through God and to God**. It takes place by Him either using or not using man (and means). It is practical. It is full of the Life of Christ.

Healed healing deals with the reality of suffering *and* sin *and* spirits of evil – also in relation to disease and dis-ease. Healed healing turns away from all pseudo-truth, from all merely subjective truth, from all lies, and returns to the Living Truth and all truth that will stand *His* scrutiny.

Just as any process of healing without the “ancestral” spirits (demons) is NOT African traditional healing any more – and this cannot be denied – in the same way, any process of healing without Christ is NOT Christian Biblical healing any more!

Therefore, let us “stand by the roads and **look**; and ask for the eternal paths, where **the good, old way** is” (Jer 6:16a), **God’s way**, and walk in *that*. Thus we’ll find rest for our souls *and* true **heavenly healing** – both for us and for others, to God’s glory.

This is our privilege and responsibility as sons and daughters of God, ...and as health-workers and co-workers with God.

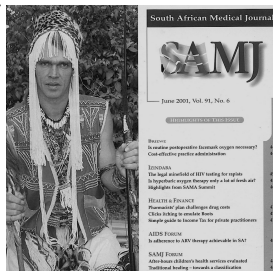
The Cure of Healing

There is a desperate need today for healing to be cured. Healing has become sick. To many people healing has become a *right*, instead of a *relationship*. It has become a search for a quick fix - a pill or a plant or a prayer - instead of a Person, Jesus Christ. It has become something you can buy, something you can “get” (through self-help or state-help). Most healing has become utterly selfish, with satanic forms of “healing” also rapidly on the increase.

Healing has become sick

Despite the cry for evidence-based medicine, the “truth” about healing has become experiential and subjective. Even the “truth” about medicine and remedies has become sick. Millions of people are deceived by lies that are propagated through the popular, as well as religious and “scientific” media. Many, many remedies on the market today (both plants and pills) have *not* been validated by reliable, scientifically sound research. The statement “research has shown” only carries weight to the *uninformed* about *reliable* research methodologies.

The Truth that led us out of the dark ages of shamanistic medical magic has become relative and compromised, through cultural “contextualization” and “cultured” secular thinking. Many Christians have “compassionately” ignored the truth that the



Bible declares: “...the whole world is under the control of the evil one” (1 John 5:19b); and, ...“The god of this age has blinded the minds of the unbelievers” (2 Co 4:4); and, ...“Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour” (1 Pet 5:8 – written to Christians); and, ...“Dear friends, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are *from God*, because many false prophets have gone out into the world”. Whenever we depart from the truth of the Word of God, including these truths, healing becomes sick.

The root cause of this sickness of healing is not materialism, nor mysticism, nor magic (and witchcraft), nor Me-ism, but... the absence of Jesus Christ Himself! Wholeness without Him is sick. All healing without Christ as the Center and Goal is *not* true healing at all.

If Christ is not the root and fruit (and all) of “Western” “scientific” medicine, then that form of healing is sick. If Christ is not the beginning and the end (and all) of African Traditional medicine, then that form of medicine too is sick. It needs Jesus Christ. If Christ is not the heart and soul of Ayurvedic medicine and Unani medicine and Chinese traditional medicine, then those forms of medicine are sick!

Wholeness without Him is sick...

I'm sick of seeking for the “good” in this or that form of healing, when the only “Good” is left out – Jesus Christ, the Son of God. When will we bring back the King in healing?!

If you're a doctor or an inyanga or a herbalist or an acupuncturist or a chiropract or a pastor or a herbalist or a nutritionist or a who-so-ever, and your form and practice of healing does not come *from Christ*, is not practiced *through Christ* and is not *to Christ*, it is sick (if not Satanic). Oh, let us repent of our idolatry and let us bring back Christ!

The cure of healing is Christ.

The cure is not communication, or caring, or competence, or compassion, or cultural understanding, or “community”, or empathy, or listening, or talking, or tablets, or technology, or religion, or relationships, or education, or “exorcism”, or specialization, or songs, or integration, or ESP, or experiences, or meditation, or herbs, or human efforts (in any form). No, **the Cure is Christ**. He should become, and daily be, a living bright Reality to the health worker as well as the patient and his family and community, practically. This leads to true healing.

The Cure of healing is Christ!

True healing is Christ-centered, Christ-mediated and glorifies God. It has not a drop of demonic darkness in it. (In Him is **no** darkness at all.) True healing affects the person and all his relationships, including his relationship with God, all people, all created beings and all of creation. It affects the *whole* person – physically, psychologically, spiritually and socially (1 Thes 5:23; John 7:23,24).). It includes the way he (or she) thinks, behaves, feels, reasons, relates, communicates, expresses, enjoys, eats, drinks, sleeps, walks, talks, decides, wills, works, prays, plays, raises children, jokes, solves problems and lives his
