1. **DEFINITION:**

Final and complete superiority in war; successful military engagement; success attained in a contest or struggle over an opponent, obstacle or problem; the act of triumphing or state of having triumphed.

Victory presupposes an enemy.

Triumph: The feeling of exultation and happiness derived from victory or major

achievement or condition of being victorious

Success: Favourable outcome of something attempted

Mastery: Full command of understanding of a subject; outstanding skill, expertise; the

power of command of control; victory, superiority

Achievement: Something that has been accomplished especially by hard work, ability or

heroism

Life: The state or quality that distinguishes living beings/organisms from dead ones

and from organic matter, characterised by growth, metabolism, ability to

reproduce and respond to stimuli.

Victorious Living: A state or quality of existence, marked by a growing achievement of

success in all areas - spirit, soul, body - with constant superiority over

all that would oppose such a life.

A consistent expression of the fullness of life in Christ, independent of

outward circumstances. Rom 5:17b

 - 4.1.3. Temptation: 1 Cor 10:13

God has made abundant provision for us to live in victory. His resources are more than adequate, but if we do not know and use them, we will not benefit from them.

7. HOW TO MAINTAIN VICTORY:

- 7.1. Vigilance and prayer: **Eternal vigilance is the price of victory** 1 Pet 5:8; Luke 22:40
- 7.2. **Realistic attitude to life:** John 10:10; 8:36; 14:27; 15:11 (abundance, joy, peace, freedom) but also John 16:33; 15:18-21 (trouble is normal)
- 7.3. **Expect victory**, because God has made provision for this. 2 Pet 1:3,4
- 7.4. **Keep short accounts:** 1 John 1:9 Don't let matters pile up
- 7.5. **Refuse accusation and condemnation:** Rom 8:1. Watch out for the enemy! 1 Pet 5:8,9
- 7.6. **Maintain a vital relationship with Jesus:** John 15:5,6

7.6.1. Dwell in the Word Col 3:16

7.6.2. Talk to Him in prayer: 1 Thess 5:17

7.6.3. Be secure in your position in Him: Eph 2:6

- 7.7. **Co-operate with Him:** Phil 2:13
- 7.8. **Believe His promises.**

7.9. Application:

Divide into groups of 3 - 6 persons. Each group to take one set of scriptures, and one verse to be assigned to each person. The person is to read the verse aloud, inserting his/her own name in the appropriate place in the verse.

Example: Heb 13:5,6: "Let <u>Jane's</u> character and moral disposition be free from love of money, for He has said: 'I will never leave <u>Jane</u>, nor forsake <u>Jane</u>'. So <u>Jane</u> takes comfort and <u>Jane</u> can boldly say' The Lord is <u>Jane's</u> helper, what can man do to <u>Jane</u>?" Meditate on the meaning of what you have just read, and accept that promise for yourself.
